INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

Wire brush loose rust and wash to remove soluble salts. Surface should be oil and grease free.

Can be sprayed or brushed (40 microns coat is considered optimum for brushing). 60 micron can be achieved by spraying.

Shake can well before use.

Can be applied on to a damp surface and will dry quickly.

Do not allow to freeze.

Use within 12 months.
